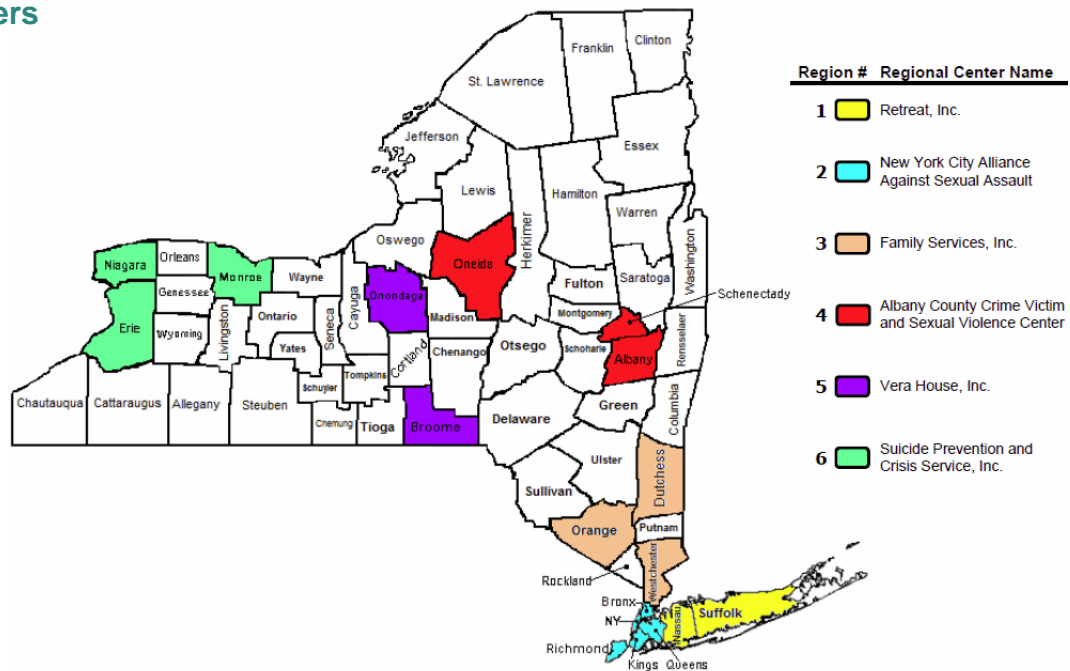

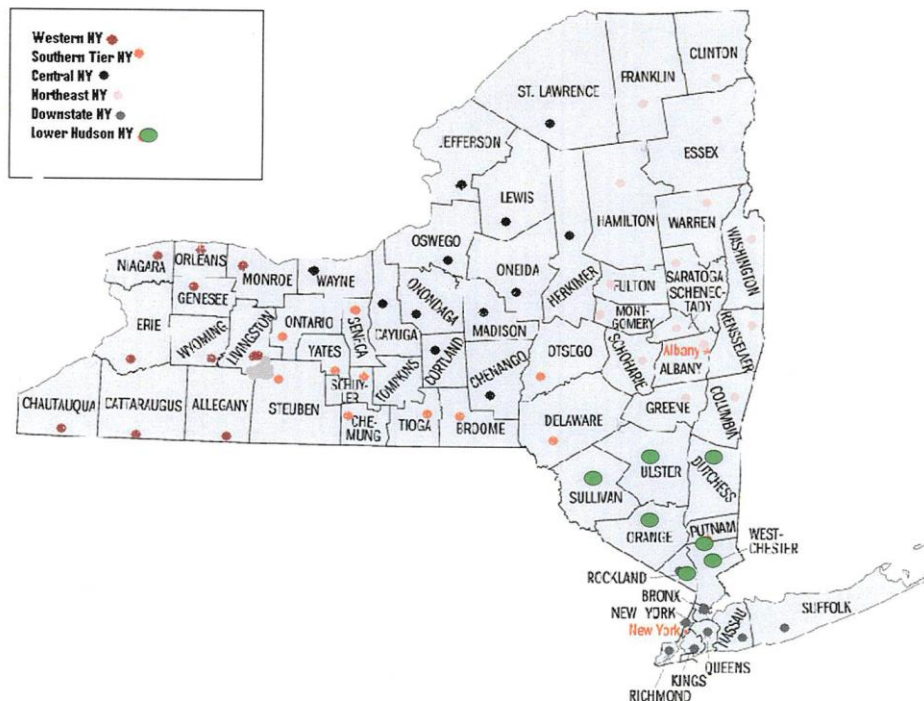

SPEAKER BIOGRAPHIES

Walter Davies is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker employed by the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS). Mr. Davies coordinates underage drinking initiatives including the OASAS College Environmental Prevention Grant, and previously, the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention's (OJJDP) Enforcing the Underage Drinking Laws Grant Program (EUDL) from 2006 to 2014. He has over 27 years of experience with the majority of his work focusing on the treatment of families and adolescents suffering from alcohol and drug disorders. Mr. Davies coordinated alcohol and substance abuse treatment and prevention services for the juvenile justice population in the NYS Office of Children and Family Services from 1997 to 2006. He has been an adjunct field instructor for the School of Social Welfare, University at Albany, State University of New York since 1995.

Elise C. Lopez, DrPH, MPH is the Assistant Director of the Relationship Violence Program at The University of Arizona's College of Public Health. Since 2004, Lopez has worked primarily on public health projects including design, implementation, and evaluation of substance abuse and relationship violence interventions. Lopez specializes in community and environmental-level interventions for sexual violence prevention, and has served as the Statewide Evaluation Coordinator for the Arizona Safer Bars Alliance since 2014. In addition to public health qualifications, she holds degrees in Public Policy and Management and in Criminal Justice Administration. She was the recipient of the inaugural Youth, Family, and Community Evidence-Based Practice Award from the Center for Substance Abuse Treatment of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in 2007. She is a member of the Arizona Institutions of Higher Education (AziHE) network, and chairs the Restorative Responses working group of the national Campus PRISM Project (Promoting Restorative Initiatives for Sexual Misconduct). She has given invited and refereed talks on sexual violence prevention and response in venues such as the National Sexual Assault Conference, American Public Health Association Annual Meeting, and Ontario Government Summit on Sexual Violence, and her work has been published in the CUNY Law Review, several books, trade journals, and public media.

Ana is the Director of Legal Services at Day One, an organization that partners with youth to end dating abuse through community education, supportive services, legal advocacy and leadership development. Through direct legal representation and advocacy, Andrew works to amplify the voices of young survivors experiencing intimate partner violence. Nationwide, Andrew trains on dating violence, the rights of young people, serving LGBTQ survivors, and cyberharassment. In 2016, Andrew became an adjunct clinical professor at New York Law School to direct the nation's first law school based legal clinic to serve victims of cyberharassment. In 2011, he was awarded a Courage award from the NYC City Anti-Violence Project for his work to set up and administer a free legal clinic for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer survivors of intimate partner violence.

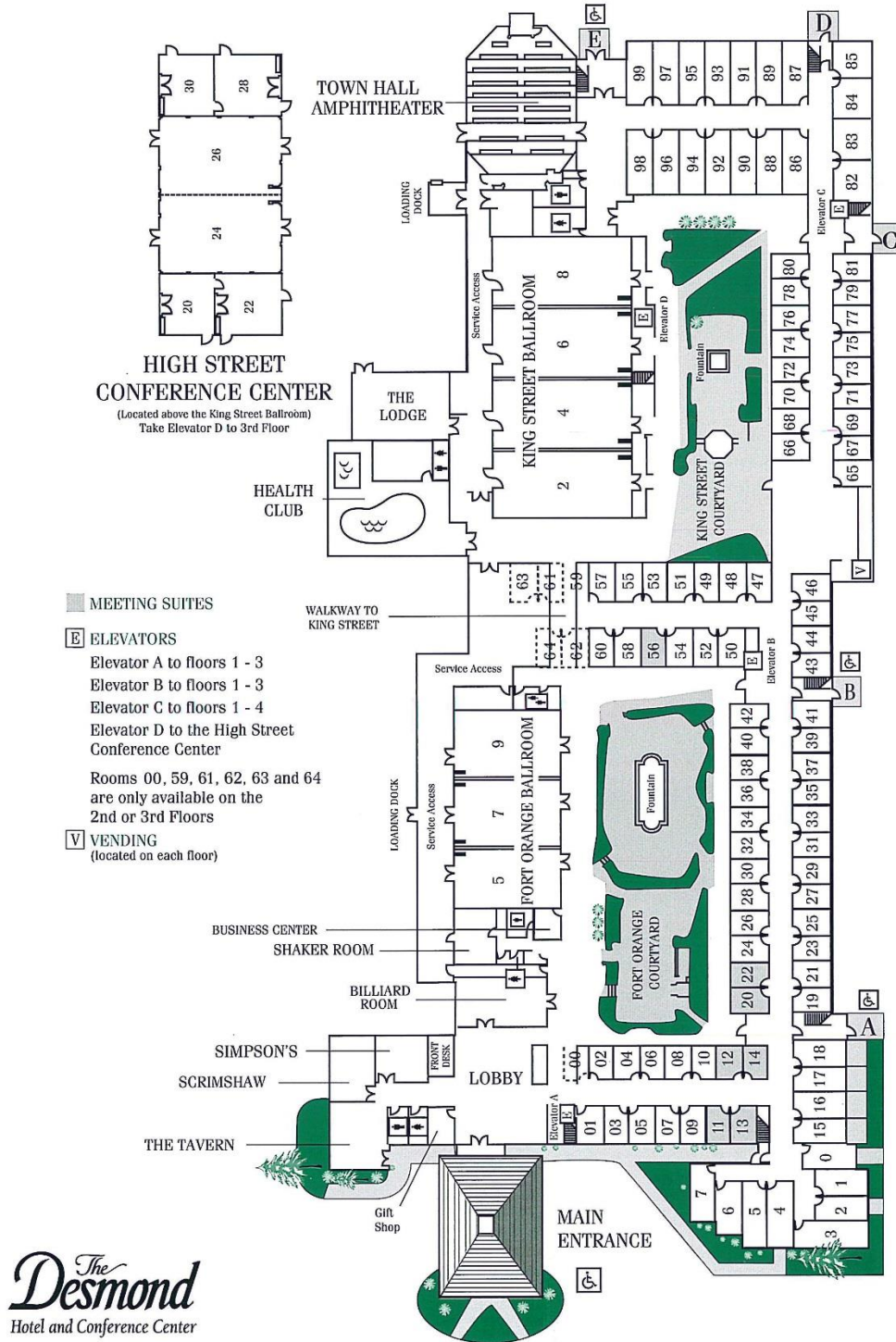

DIRECTIONS TO COLONIE CENTER

From the North take I-87 South to Exit 26, Colonie Center will be on the left.

From the South take I-87, Stay in the RIGHT LANE and take Exit 2E, Wolf Road. At the end of the exit ramp, proceed straight through the stoplight. Colonie Center will be on the right.

From the East take I-90 to I-87 North and exit at Exit 2E, Wolf Road. At the end of the exit ramp, proceed straight through the stoplight. Colonie Center will be on the right.

From the West take I-87, Stay in RIGHT LANE and take Exit 2E, Wolf Road. At the end of the exit ramp, proceed straight through the stoplight. Colonie Center will be on the right.

DIRECTIONS TO CROSSGATES MALL

From the North take I-87 South to Crossgates Mall Road Exit.

From the South take I-87 North to Exit 24, go through tolls, take Crossgates Mall Road Exit.

From the East take I-90 West to Exit 15 (Route 20/Western Ave) to Crossgates Mall Road Exit.

From the West take I-90 East to Exit 24, go through tolls, take Crossgates Mall Road Exit.

DIRECTIONS TO STUYVESANT PLAZA

From the North take I-87 South to the end, then left on Western Ave (Route 20).

From the South take I-87 North to Exit 24 to I-87 South to the end, then left on Western Ave (Route 20).

From the East take I-90 West to I-87 Road Exit, turn left on Fuller Road and follow to Stuyvesant Plaza on the right.

From the West take I-90 East, take Exit 24 to I-87 South to the end, then left on Western Ave (Route 20).
